

Brief intro


- The aim is to explore different approaches to bringing culture and creativity to life with joy and professionalism under corona conditions and especially across national borders.

key goal: having cultural exchanges




Online Music Making

- Our approach uses the online music software *Jamulus* and we agreed on a specific hardware setup to minimize technical problems at the different locations.
- In connection with the concert preparation, we also gained a number of insights into the design of rehearsals. These are to be further elaborated in follow-up projects.




We rehearse always in the same „rehearsal room“ on Jamulus

- Open Jamulus
- 1. To join our rehearsal room click on "connect" first
- 2. then click on "List" in the new window that appears and select "Classic & Folk".
- 3. search for "SquirrelJam1 (BKC)"
- 4. Double click on the "SquirrelJam1 (BKC)"
- Use Zoom or WhatsApp or Skype for the video interaction.
- Use our google doc to find a good date for your rehearsal.






